ANNUAL REPORT 2023-2024

DEPARTMENT OF ZOOLOGY

The Department of Zoology had its Association Inauguration on 19.07.2023. Over 180 students of the department attended the inauguration ceremony. Dr. K. Marimuthu was the resource person and he delivered a special lecture on "The usage of MS-Excel for statistical analysis highlighting its significance" and demonstrated the functioning of descriptive statistical options. On 07.09.2023, students of II M.Sc. Zoology accompanied by Dr. T. Pushpanathan and Dr. S. Mabel Parimala went on a one-day education tour to Keezhadi Heritage Museum, Sivagangai and Instrumental Facility of School of Biological Sciences, Madurai Kamaraj University, Madurai as a part of their Cell and Molecular Biology & Evolution Practical curriculum. On 15.09.2023,II B.Sc. Zoology students visited Manapad, Punnaikayal, and Melaputhukudi regions as a part of their Ecology Practical Course accompanied by Dr. R. SanthaKumari and Dr. K. Sahayaraj. The students were exposed to assessment procedures on pollution and studied the coastal, estuary, and terrestrial ecosystems, especially analyzing the physico-chemical parameters of water.

The Zoology Association organized a special lecture on 21.09.2023at 11.45 a.m. in the UG lab. Dr. M. R. Sudhakaran, Head & Associate Professor, Department of Zoology, Sri Paramakalyani College, Alwarkurichi, Tenkasi addressed on the "Role of Bats in Environment Sustainability". He highlighted the crucial roles played by bats in maintaining environment through various ecological functions like pollination, seed dispersal, insect control, nutrient cycling, ecosystem balance, economic value and scientific research. On 14.11.2023,an online quiz was conducted in view of World Diabetes Day in which around 100 participants attempted the quiz. On 28.11.2023 &29.11.2023, the Department of Zoology in association with the Department of Botany organized a two-day National Workshop on "Cell imaging and cytological

techniques using bright field, fluorescence and phase contrast microscopy" sponsored by Incise Infotech Pvt. Ltd. The workshop had 35 participants from 11 colleges.

On 14.12.2023, the Zoology Association conducted an invited lecture at 11.45 a.m. Dr. K. Mallika, Head & Professor, Department of Basic Principles of Medicine, Siddha Medical College, Tirunelveli gave a special talk on "For a Prosperous and Healthy Life". In her address, she pointed out the importance of Siddha in mitigating diseases. She highlighted the mention of ancient texts advocating for the protection of human health and longevity based on dietary principles. On 15.12.2023,14 II M.Sc. Zoology students embarked on a field visit to the Central Salt and Marine Chemicals Research Institute-Algal Research Station (CSMCRI) and Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) in Rameshwaram. The journey provided students with invaluable insights into marine research and seaweed production.

On 24.01.2024, the department conducted ZOOFEST 2024, an inter-collegiate competition. 65 students from 7 neighboring colleges participated in various events, viz. elocution, essay writing, model making, poster making, specimen collection, quiz and paper presentation. Students of S.T. Hindu College, Nagercoil won the overall championship with a rolling trophy for this academic year, 2023-2024. On 30.01.2024, the Department of Botany and Department of Zoology in association with the Placement Cell of SXC organized 'Career Guidance for Outgoing Students of Life Sciences' in Botany UG Lab from 12 noon to 1.30 p.m. Mr. Injamamulhaq, the CEO and Founder of IMCI Universe Private Limited, Tirunelveli gave a talk on "Scope of Medical Coding". He highlighted the need and demand for life science graduates in the medical coding industry. All the final-year students of the Botany and Zoology department participated in this event.

On 15.02.2024, the department arranged a one-hour guest lecture for the II B Sc., I M Sc., and II M Sc. Zoology students in the UG Zoology Lab at 3 p.m. Mr. V. Edwin Joseph, Former Officer in charge, Library and Documentation Division, CMFRI, Kochi outlined the framework of the fisheries department in India, and the various fisheries institutes working for the livelihood enhancement of the fishermen community. He issued his monthly magazine *Aquaculture Spectrum* to the students, and contributes many of his books to the department

library for reference. V. Kalai Selvan (22UZO137) thanked the speaker. M.K. Shriram (22UZO101) hosted the lecture.



On 21.02.2024, a one-day National Conference on "Biodiversity Restoration: Current Trends and Emerging Opportunities" with the theme of restoring biodiversity for the revival of life was organized by Dr. T. Elizabeth and Dr. J. Ronald. The technical sessions started with the keynote address by Dr. T. R. Vinod, Programme Director, Centre for Environment and Development, Trivandrum, Kerala, who spoke on ecosystem restoration for the people, the planet and the climate, followed by three plenary lectures by Dr. V. Deepak Samuel, Scientist-E, CMR- Conservation of Coastal and Marine Resource Division, National Centre for Sustainable Coastal Management, Chennai, who talked on the evolution, ecology and ethology of cephalopods. Dr. K. Diraviyaraj, Associate Professor, Suganthi Devadason Marine Research Institute, Tuticorin, pondered on the restoration of coral reefs and sea grasses of Gulf of Mannar. Dr. L. Ranjith, Senior Scientist, Marine Biodiversity and Environment Management Division, Tuticorin Regional Station, ICAR-CMFRI, Thoothukudi focussed on the way forward in Indian jellyfish research. Over 210 from 18 colleges attended the conference.

On 27.02.2024, the Entomology Practical curriculum industrial visit to Agricultural College and Research Institute, Killikulam, led by Dr. T Pushpanathan and Dr. T Elizabeth, marked an enriching experience for the III B.Sc. Zoology students. The visit aimed to provide hands-on exposure to the practical aspects of entomology, emphasizing its applications in agriculture and research. On 29.02.2024, the Zoology Association Valediction of Zoology Association was arranged. Mr. N. Sridharan, Ecologist, Kalakad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve, Tirunelveli gave a special talk on "Wildlife and its Conservation in Kalakkad Mundanthurai Tiger Reserve".
