The meeting began with prayer by Dr Benjamin Franklin, Dean of Arts.

Rev. Dr. S. Mariadoss, S.J., Principal welcomed the members and explained the significance of BMS programme.

Mr. R. Murugesan, Chairman of BoS, said that BMS Degree Programme could not be started in June 2020 due to Covid-19 pandemic situation. The programme will be started in June 2021.

Prof. S. Ganesan said that BMS programme will ensure 100% placement through apprenticeship.

in reputed organizations. During the fifth and sixth semesters, the students will be engaged in apprenticeship and will be eligible to get stipend.

Dr. Unnikrishnan stated that students need to be creative so as to be fit for employment. He explained the salient features of the domain courses offered in I, II, III and IV semesters. He also pointed out that outsourcing of logistics is a big business now.

Prof. S. Ganesan explained the difference between apprenticeship and internship. While internship is only observation and optional, apprenticeship is on-the-job training and obligatory. While internship is only self and short programme, apprenticeship is legal and long programme.

Prof. S. Ganesan also pointed out that the students will get a Government Certificate at the end of apprenticeship.

Prof. Gayathri Harish said that the performance of students in I, II, III and IV semesters would be assessed by the college and that their performance in V and VI semesters would be assessed by various modes such as evaluation by the personnel in the industry, viva voce, etc.

It was resolved to add more Course Outcomes and do mapping as per Bloom's Outcome-Based Education model.

Mr. Babakar said that women are doing challenging tasks at present and that our women students are capable of performing the modules in BMS programme.

It was resolved to follow 50:50 for Continuous Internal Assessment and External Examination. Prof. S. Ganesan appreciated this system because it reflects the true spirit of autonomy.

Dr. X. Lourdasamy proposed a vote of thanks. There being no further business, the meeting came to an end at 1.00 p.m.

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


