MCA syllabus:-

* For the 'OOPs with C++' paper, the author Herbert Schildt book can be kept as the text book.

* If MCA programme is to be changed as a 2-yr^s programme, the Operating System paper

and Database Management system paper should be moved to Semester III, as they are of significance.

* Software Engineering and Software Testing papers could be put into one paper.

* Python programming paper should be placed instead of Computer Graphics & Multimedia in the III Semester.

* For Database Management Systems Course, Deon & Deon book can be included for reference.


* In Web Technologies paper, Java Script can be included
